Mark your calendars and look for more details in upcoming issues of *Sportsmate*:

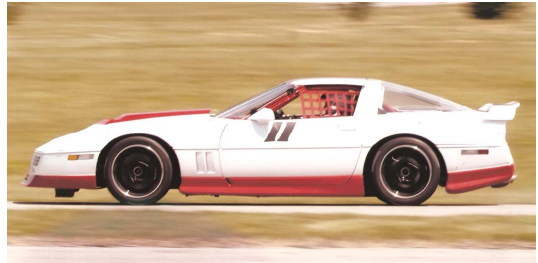
