Chevy Unveils Zora: A Hybrid Corvette Ready to Take On the Hypercar World

General Motors has officially unveiled the much-anticipated Chevrolet Corvette Zora, the crown jewel of the eighth-generation Corvette lineup. This hybrid beast boasts a twin-turbocharged V8 engine paired with an electric motor, pushing the boundaries of performance with a rumored 1,000 horsepower and sub-3-second 0-60 mph times.

The Zora represents a significant leap forward for Corvette. It's not just about raw power; it's a technological marvel that blends the thrill of a gasoline engine with the efficiency of electric propulsion. This innovative drivetrain, coupled with all-wheel drive and a lightweight chassis, promises to deliver unparalleled performance on both the straights and corners.

In addition to the CCI program shown above, there will be many opportunities throughout the West Region to participate in auto crossing and car show events. I urge you to check the Competition area of the West Region website for complete information.

Another premier event coming to our area is the GoodGuys show. This will occur on July 5-7 at the Iowa State Fairgrounds in Des Moines. There will be in excess of 4,500 cars on the grounds, in addition to many vendors and other attractions. There will be 3 days of auto crossing. You can watch, or you can participate. The competition will be fierce. If you plan to participate in this auto cross event, I urge you to go to the GoodGuys Rod and Custom website and check out the rules for participation in the auto cross event.

Good weather will be here soon. Be prepared to enjoy it.


Competition Driving Events
