Competition director Mark Cooper and I have met a couple of times to discuss what we would like to accomplish this year in terms of competitive events. However, we learned that NASCAR's Midwest Division, consisting of the following tracks: Kansas Speedway, Iowa Speedway, Chicagoland Speedway & Route 66 Dragway, and Michigan International Speedway, has set a standard fee for renting any of the race tracks in division. That cost is significantly out of our price range, so it is no longer a possibility. We are, however, working on alternative sites to use for our speed We still plan to host a events this year. Memorial Day weekend autocross, another autocross September 23-24, and a couple of other events TBD.

Please don't forget that the NCCC Convention is June 24-30 this year in Bowling Green, Kentucky. That's not a bad drive from Iowa and the 2023 Convention Committee has a lot of fun activities planned, in addition to the competition events.


